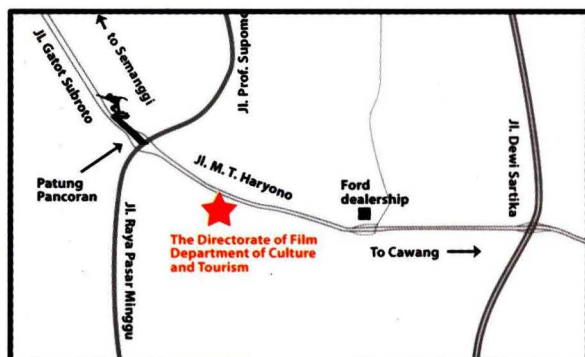

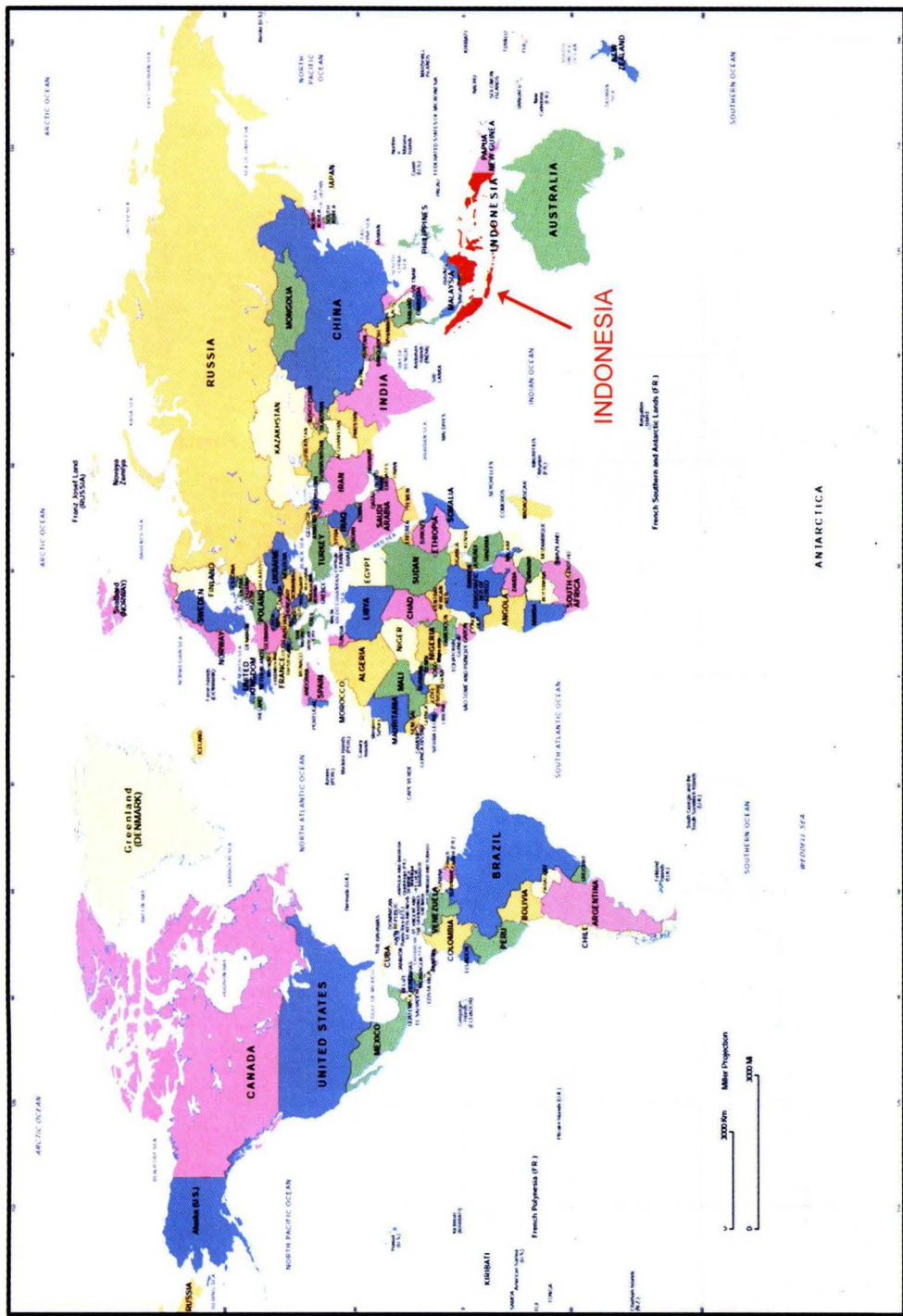



INDONESIA AT A GLANCE

Geography

Indonesia is an archipelago stretched across the equator covering 1.9 million square miles, comprising of some 17,504 islands, many of which are still uninhabited. Geographically, Indonesia is rich in natural resources, exotic panorama, and warm climates.

Climate and Seasons

Indonesia's climate is basically tropical, hot and humid. However, as the country is very large, climate can vary significantly between places. In the coastal and low-lying areas it is generally hot and humid, but in highlands and mountainous areas it can be moderate. There are 2 seasons, the dry season from May to October, and the rainy season from October to April. In the dry season, day temperature can reach 34° Celsius (93°F). In the rainy season there are occasional monsoons.

People and Culture

Indonesia is the third most populated country in the world, with approximately 228.9 million inhabitants. The island of Java is one of the most densely populated islands in the world, and the capital Jakarta is the world's fifth most populated cities with 12 million inhabitants.

With so many inhabitants, Indonesia is rich in cultural diversity. There are hundreds of ethnic group making up the Indonesian people, all live harmoniously, bound by the country's philosophy of "Unity in Diversity". The religions of the people also vary, Islam comprised the largest majority, but there are Christianity, Catholic, Hindu, Buddhism, and Kong Hu Chu practitioners as well. Our great diversity, coupled with wide-range of natural resources, has together become an invaluable treasure to Indonesia.

Government

Indonesia has a republic government system. We are the third largest democracy in the world, after India and the United States. The President, elected directly by the public every five years, serves as the Chief of State and Chief of Government. A two tier representative body embodies the will of the people in the government. The legal system is derived from the Roman Dutch law, modified over the years to suit the local culture and situations. Indonesia is divided into 33 provinces, each headed by a governor. These provinces have been granted more autonomy since 2002 reform. The capital city is Jakarta, considered as a province in itself, and is the center of both governmental and commercial activities in Indonesia.

Communication

Communication infrastructures in Indonesia have advanced significantly in the last decade. Mobile cellular services, in particular, have grown immensely, and today cellular phone coverage has been extended to large extent of the populated areas. Line telephone services are quite extensive as well, and internet connection and internet cafes are available in many cities and popular tourist destinations. Government-owned postal services reach even the most remote areas, and courier and package delivery services both local and international (DHL, TNT, UPS, FedEx, etc.) are able to deliver packages and documents to most areas.

Transportation

More places in Indonesia are now accessible by air than ever before, after the deregulation of airline services in late 1990s, and the proliferation of private airline companies afterward. Rates have dropped as well, making air travel more affordable. Traveling by air is generally the fastest and most efficient way to travel in Indonesia owing to the country's archipelagic geography and vast distances. There are several international airports in the country that offer direct international connection.

Rail services are only available in the island of Java and part of Sumatra. Intercity bus services are extensively available in Java and Sumatra, less so in other islands. Buses are often the cheapest way to travel between cities. Car rentals are available at most larger cities and popular tourist destinations. Car rentals usually include a driver, which is good since most roads in rural areas are not well marked, and can be very confusing. Public transportation is available in most places, usually in the form of minibuses, though their routes are usually not well marked or defined, and can be confusing to non-locals.

Language

Bahasa Indonesia is the country's national language. Almost everyone speak this language. However, in line with the vast diversity of ethnics and cultures, there are approximately over 250 native languages spoken across the country, often as primary languages. English are taught in secondary schools, though fluent English-speaking people are still rare outside of the bigger cities.

Time Zone

Indonesia has three different time zones. The western areas (Sumatra, Java, West and Central Kalimantan) has West Indonesian Time (Waktu Indonesia Barat – WIB), which is GMT+7. Central Indonesian Time (Bali, Lombok, Nusa Tenggara islands, Sulawesi, South and East Kalimantan) is GMT+8, while East Indonesian Time (Irian Jaya and the Maluku islands) is GMT+9.

Public Holidays

Indonesian calendar system follows international standard, however, some of the religious holidays are counted using other calendar system, such as Islamic, Buddhist, Hindu, or lunar calendar. Thus such holidays occur on different dates each year. The most important holiday is the Idul Fitri, or the Islamic Id day, the end of the Moslem fasting month. A day prior to Idul Fitri and one or two days afterward is usually declared a National Holiday as well. Below is a list of 2007 public holidays:

Working Hours

Working days are Monday to Friday. Business hours are usually from 9 am to 5 pm, although official working hours are from 8 am to 4 pm. Bank hours are from 9 am to 3 pm, and foreign exchange is usually handled only until 1 pm. Offices usually closed between 12 am to 1 pm for lunch, and between 11.30 am to 1.30 pm on Friday to allow for Moslem prayer. Some offices may open half a day on Saturday.

Accommodation

Hotels and other places to stay are widely available in most places. Luxurious, four and five-star hotels, resorts, and apartments are available in larger cities and popular tourist destinations, many are operated by international hotel chains. Temporary rental houses or guest houses are also widely available, at widely varied rates, conditions, and range of services. Restaurants and other places to eat are also commonly available, but restaurants serving international foods are available only in larger cities and popular tourist destinations.

Emergency services

Medical and emergency services are available in cities. A number of internationally-affiliated medical centers operate in the capital city of Jakarta, offering modern, state-of-the-art facilities and highly-qualified medical practitioners. Many such medical centers are associated with international health insurances and emergency evacuation services.

Events

There are several film-related events in Indonesia. Two of the major ones are:

Festival Film Indonesia

The Festival Film Indonesia or FFI (Indonesian Film Festival) is the grandest film-related event in Indonesia. Conceived to nurture and celebrate the Indonesian movie industry, the event is where the Citra trophy, the country's highest movie-related award, is presented. The Citra award is similar in spirit to other movie industry award such as the Academy Awards, and is awarded in many similar categories such as Best Film, Best Actor and Actress and supporting actors/actresses, Best Director, Best Film Score, and so on.

Jakarta International Film Festival

The Jakarta International Film Festival (JIFFEST) is the major film festival of Indonesia held every year in the capital, Jakarta every December since 1998. The event showcases both local and international films, especially smaller and/or independent films, and films produced outside of big film-making countries. The festival has gained record attendance year after year, as it gave film enthusiasts exposure to great films that are not normally shown on commercial cinemas.

FILMING IN INDONESIA

Indonesia's stunning natural landscapes and rich cultural diversity makes it appealing as a filming location. A great variety of exotic flora and fauna, welcoming climates year round, as well as kind and gentle people, makes filming in Indonesia an experience not to be missed.

Filming facilities

For the purpose of film productions in Indonesia, there are various filming facilities available in the country. Shooting equipment rentals, pre- and post-production facilities, studios, special effects and computer graphics / animations, computer and communication equipments, sound equipments and sound studios, supporting casts and experienced crews for hire are widely available, supported by the country's thriving TV production industry. Supporting facilities such as transportation providers, guides/interpreters, translation services, legal consultants, and so on are also easily found. The Directory areas on the back of this book contain contact information for some of these services.

Laws and Regulations

Visas

To enter Indonesia, visitors from most countries need a valid visa. Visitors from ASEAN member countries and several other countries are exempt from entry visa requirement. Individuals participating in a film production in Indonesia need a special work visa. Visa application can be made through Indonesian embassies or consular offices, or other offices designated by the Government of Indonesia. General requirements for visa applications include: a valid passport, a round trip ticket or a through ticket to another destination, two 4x6 photos, written proof of financial sufficiency during stay in Indonesia, and proof of visa fee payment.

Customs

Film producers intending to make films in Indonesia are permitted to enter the country bringing film equipments, subject to the applicability of temporary admission exempt of import tax. To obtain such facility, film producers must fill an application form, and submit it to the Custom Authority of the entry port entered. If such application is approved, bond must be placed in the amount of the prevailing import duty and tax, but will be refunded upon the re-importation of the equipments. Temporary import period is valid for 12 months after the issuance of the approval, and is extendable.

Permits

The Directorate of Film of the Department of Culture and Tourism is the authority that issues shooting permit in Indonesia. With the issuance of such permit, you can then secure any local permit that you need to shoot in a particular location. For more detailed information, please see the **Filming Procedure** section of this book. There are usually additional expenses required to facilitate shooting on location. Our office can help you secure these location permits and any other permits you might need, and in obtaining visas, work permits, and other procedures should you decide to do your filming in Indonesia.

Supporting Facilities

Banking and currency

The Indonesian currency is Rupiah, abbreviated Rp. Money changers are widely available in cities and popular tourist destinations. Foreign currencies commonly traded include US dollars, Singapore dollars, Yen, Australian dollars, Euros, Pounds, Baht, Malaysian Ringgit, etc, with US dollars being the most commonly accepted. Other currencies can be exchanged at foreign exchange banks and certain money changers. Local banks usually able to facilitate international banking transactions and many foreign banks have branches in the capital city, Jakarta, and a few of the larger cities as well. Credit card usage has grown more popular in recent years, and businesses accepting credit cards have become more common, especially in the larger cities. Businesses in rural areas and most small businesses and shops usually do not accept credit cards. ATMs are widely available in the largest cities, and smaller cities usually have a few as well, but they are usually not available in rural areas. Money changers are also often not available outside of larger cities and popular tourist destinations, so bring local currencies if you need to shoot in more remote areas.

FILMING PROCEDURES IN INDONESIA

Foreign companies intending to produce films in Indonesia is obligated to do the following:

1. The relevant foreign company must submit an application to the Department of Culture and Tourism, c.q. the Directorate of Film, through any Indonesian Representative Office in its respective country. The application shall have the following attachments:
 - a. Data of the corporation, the crews, and their positions
 - b. Copies of passports of the foreign personnel involved
 - c. Synopsis of the project to be filmed
 - d. Schedule and locations of shooting
 - e. List of equipments to be brought in to Indonesia, accompanied with statements of intention to re-export the equipments upon completion of the film production.
2. Each application is subject to administrative examination by Department of Culture and Tourism, based on which the application shall be granted or refused. The evaluation team will be comprised of officers representing the Department of Foreign Affairs, the Department of Laws and Human Rights, the Department of Culture and Tourism, and other related authorities.
3. In this regard, the Department of Culture and Tourism, c.q. the Directorate of Film will be the issuer of permits for filming in Indonesia, and will provide assistance during the production of the film in Indonesia.
4. Approval or refusal of such application shall be decided at the latest 7 (seven) working days after the completion of all requirements.
5. For filming in certain areas, the Directorate of Film may require the foreign company to be accompanied by an appointed supporting team, to ensure the smoothness of the film production. These areas are to be determined by the Directorate of Film.
6. The foreign company is obligated to submit a copy of the film produced in the form of Betacam video cassette, to the Government of Indonesia, c.q. the Department of Culture and Tourism, to be used for non-commercial purposes only.
7. Crews of the foreign companies, while conducting activities within the jurisdiction of Indonesia, is required to respect the local norms and traditions, as well as to comply with the prevailing laws and regulations.

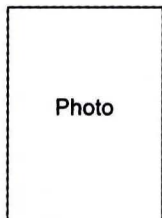

STATEMENT

To complete our application for film or video shooting permit in Indonesia, we hereby declare that we shall:

1. Obey all regulations of the Government of the Republic of Indonesia (both Central and Provincial Government)
2. Report on our arrival in Indonesia to the Department of Culture and Tourism, c.q. the Directorate of Film in Jakarta to obtain details of central and local rules before filming begins.
3. Be accompanied, without exception, by a liaison officer appointed by the Department of Culture and Tourism, and bear all expenses (board, lodging, transportation and daily allowances) for said officer for the duration of filming
4. Shooting should be made only in accordance of the approved script / synopsis and object / location as described in the shooting permit issued by the Department of Culture and Tourism.
5. Refrain from filming subjects / situations that might be considered harmful to the Republic of Indonesia. Department of Culture and Tourism c.q. the Directorate of Film shall be the final authority on what would be considered harmful to the Republic of Indonesia.
6. Re-export all equipments brought to Indonesia from abroad at our expense upon the completion of shooting activities, and bear all costs that might be incurred.
7. Submit 1 (one) copy of the released film/video to the Department of Culture and Tourism c.q. the Directorate of Film through the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia or Consulate General of the Republic of Indonesia, to be used for archival and purposes for the benefit of the Republic of Indonesia only.

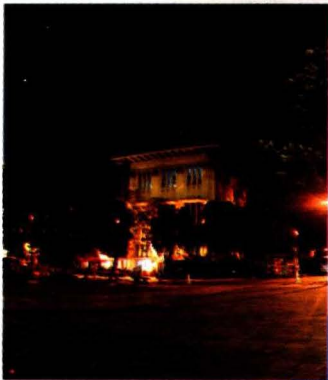

Even with all the growth, some of Jakarta's older buildings survived, such as the **Fatahillah Museum** (left), a former Dutch Colonial building.

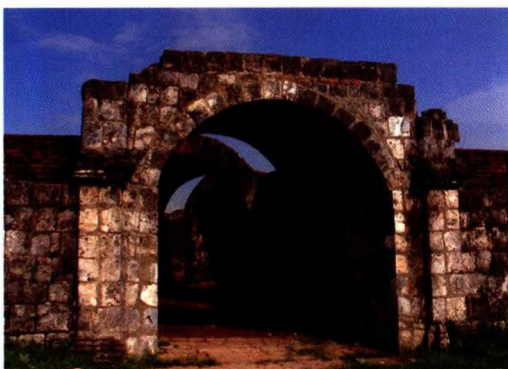
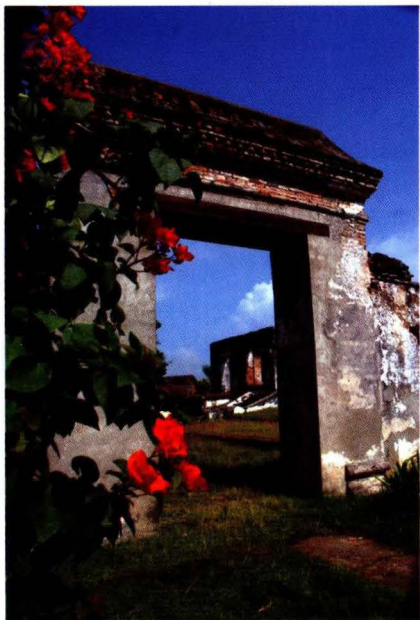

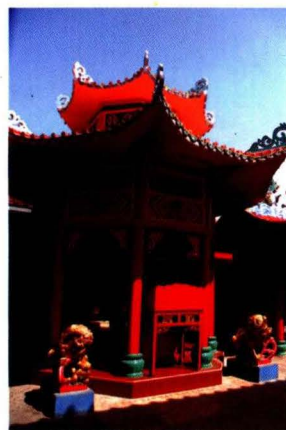
Usually referred to by the locals as simply 'Monas' is the symbol of Jakarta.

Banten is the westernmost provinces of Java. The province is rich in history, and the people of Banten are known for their strong Islamic culture and tradition.

Gedung Sate is the symbol of the city of Bandung. This historic building now functions as the office of the Governor of West Java.

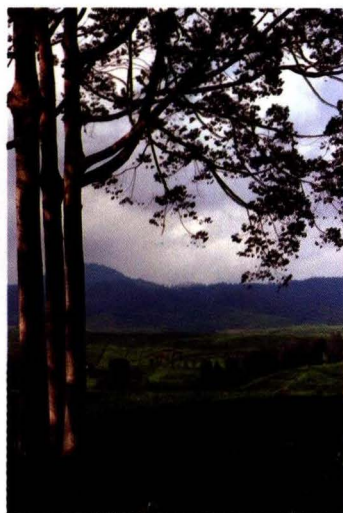




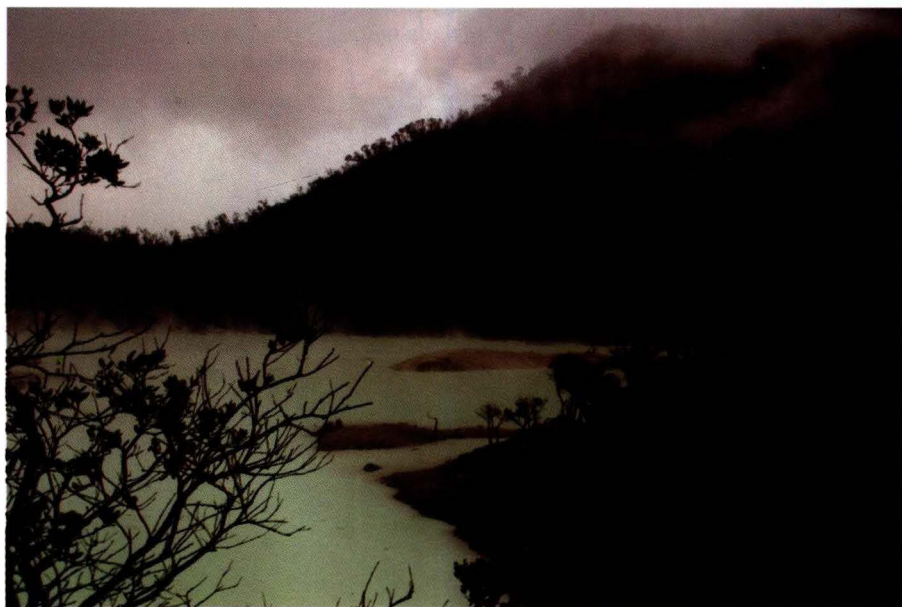
▲ **Tangkuban Perahu** is an active volcano. Its name means *overturned boat*, as that is what the mountain looks like from afar. The crater is active and emits strong smell of sulfur.

Indonesia has the highest number of active volcanoes of any country, sitting on a belt of intense volcanic and seismic activity known as the "Pacific Ring of Fire". West Java is home to a few of them.

▼ **Kawah Putih** is another active volcanic crater, which has filled with water. The water is white due to minerals emitted by the crater, hence the name, which literally means "white crater". The lake's water is quite hot smoking.



▲ Regular volcanic explosions made the ground fertile, and the mountain climate is perfect for sprawling, tranquil **tea plantations**





▲ The **Keraton** in Yogyakarta is an ancient but still functioning palace, currently serving as the residence of Sultan Hamengku Buwono XI, the traditional king of the people of Yogyakarta, and currently also serving as governor of the Yogyakarta province.

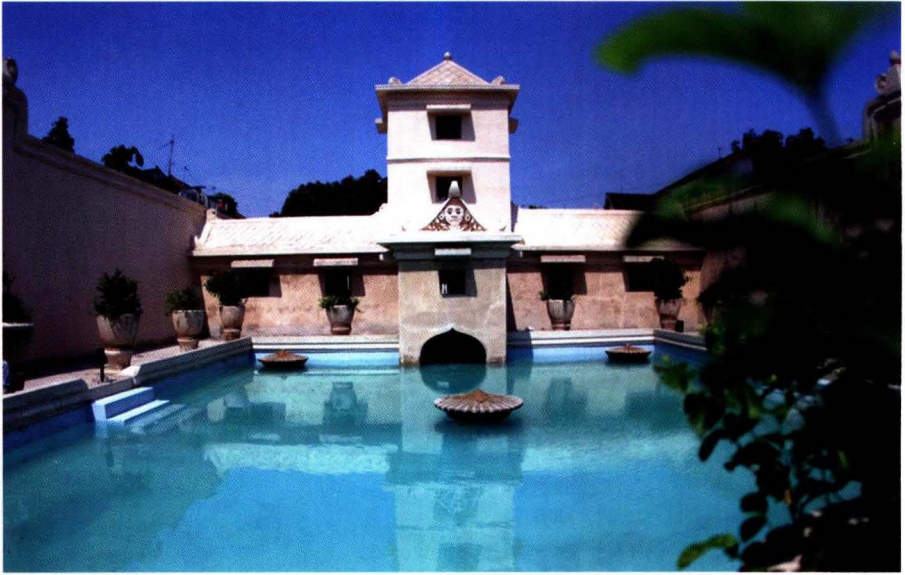
The **Yogyakarta Special Province** is a place that is especially rich in history and tradition, as it was the seat of power of the ancient Mataram empire, the last independent Javanese empire before the Dutch colonization.

The Keraton is a prime example of traditional Javanese architecture and features a large main hall called pendopo. ▶



▽ **Vredeburg Fort** (below) is a Dutch colonial fort, now a museum of history.





Tamansari, located near the Sultan's palace, the Keraton, is traditionally the bathing pool for the Sultan's concubines, built in the 18th century. The beautiful swimming complex was designed by an Italian architect.



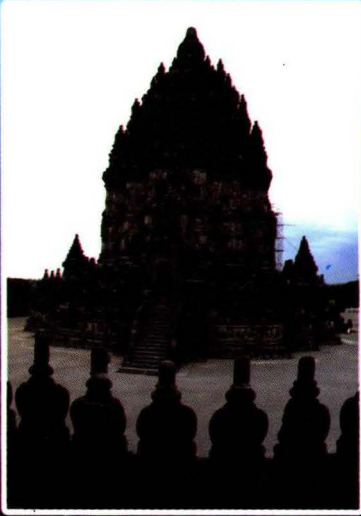


Borobudur Temple is one of the world's 7 ancient wonders. Built as a Buddhist shrine in the 8th century, Borobudur was abandoned during the decline of Indonesia's Buddhist kingdom in the 14th century, then buried under volcanic ash for hundreds of years, until it was rediscovered in 1814. Borobudur is located near the city of Yogyakarta in Central Java, and is recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site.

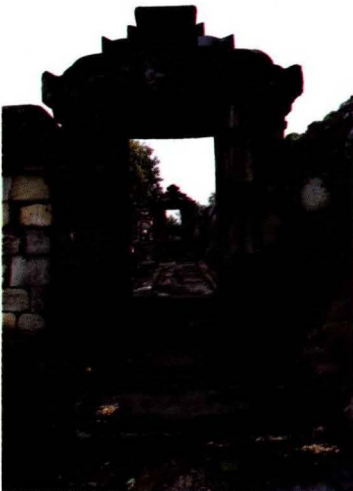
Borobudur features intricate stone carvings, and 72 stupas, each houses a statue of Buddha inside.



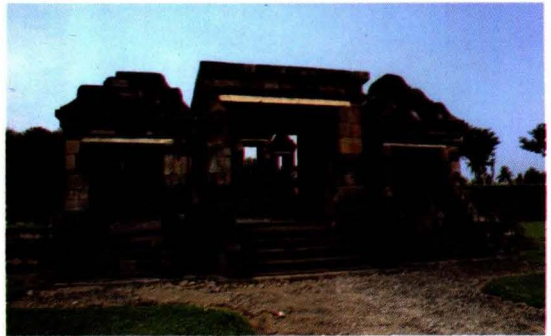

The temple feature beautiful intricate carvings and reliefs expressing the ancient Hindu story of Ramayana.



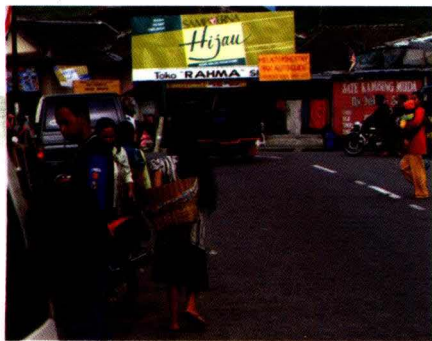
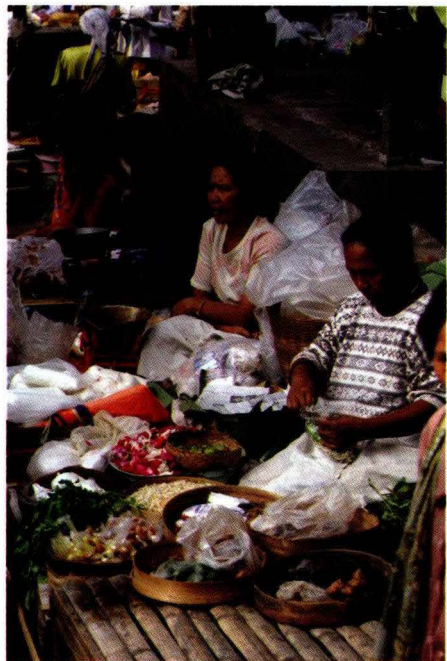
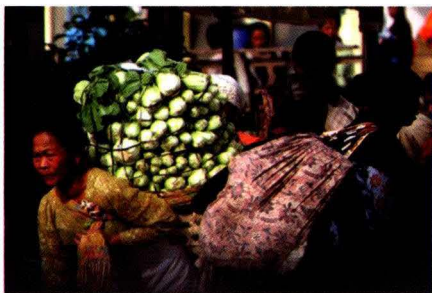
The **Ruins of Ratu Boko**, located nearby, are the remains of the palace and monastery of King Boko, built in the 8th century.

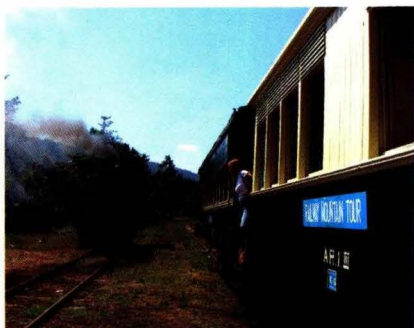




▲ Majestic **Mt. Merapi** is one of Indonesia's most active volcano, but the rich volcanic soil around it attracts people, so the surrounding area is heavily populated, despite the risk. The mountain showed some activity in late 2006, sending the local population into near panic.

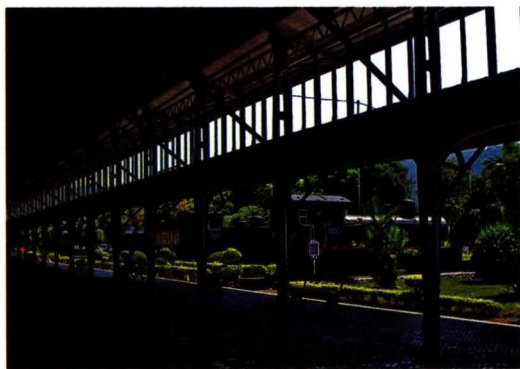
▼ This **Local Market** scene in Selo at the foot of Mt. Merapi is typical of daily small town activities in Central Java, and in Java in general.





Ambarawa is the site of the **Ambarawa Railway Museum**. The museum is the old Dutch colonial "Willem I" railway station, built in 1873.

Ambarawa in Central Java used to be an important railway junction in the island of Java. Along with the decline of railway services in the island, the city has become a quiet, peaceful, charming little city.



The museum features many working and non-working old steam locomotives. These are the ones that used to ply the island of Java in the times past.

There is a scenic railway service that runs occasionally, featuring period passenger carriages and pulled by one of the working steam locomotives.

Not far from Ambarawa, one can find **Losari Coffee Plantation**, a luxury resort and spa based on a real, working organic coffee plantation and featuring 18th century Dutch mansions and plantation houses. An old Dutch railway station serves as the resort's main entrance.

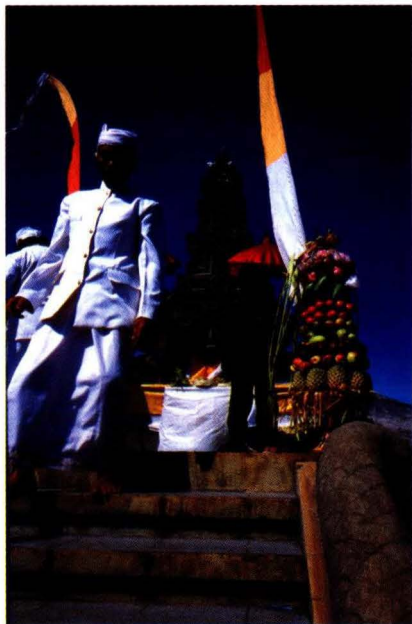




Mt. Bromo is an active volcano in East Java, one of many in Indonesia. It is located in the Bromo-Tengger National Park, which also features several other active and dormant volcanoes. Mount Bromo is capped by a huge, smoking crater in its middle. Tourists are encouraged to visit the crater at dawn, when the rising sun produces awesome, eerie visuals. Although a popular tourist destination, the volcano occasionally belches toxic clouds that can kill people. The Bromo-Tengger National Park lies between 1000 to 3676 meters above sea level, and has cool mountain climate; as a result, temperatures can reach as low as 3° Celsius.

The **Tengger tribe** that inhabit the area around Mt. Bromo lives an idyllic life untouched by modern influences, and still practices ancient rituals and ways of life. One of their most important ritual is the Kasodo ceremony, held on top of Mount Bromo and in surrounding desert during a full moon night. During the ceremony they make an offering to the Creator as a show of gratitude.



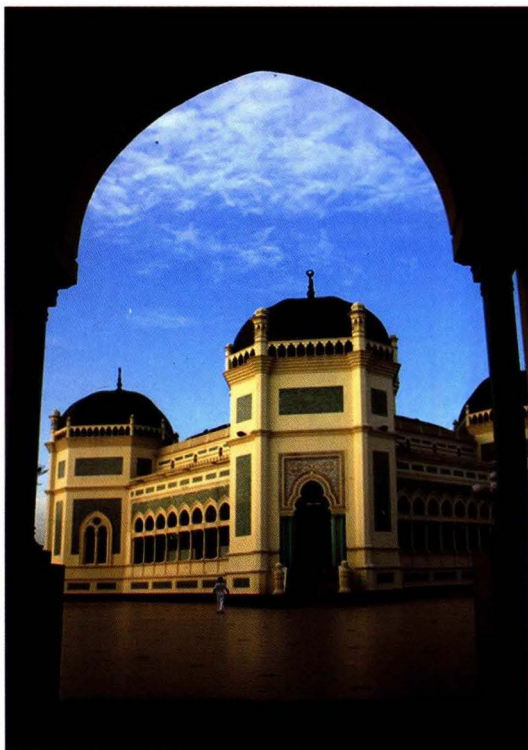


Lake Toba is one of the natural wonders of the world. Located about 4 hours' drive from Medan, the lake is situated in the highlands, has a cooler mountain climate, and is a popular resort area. The lake is the remnant of a spectacular volcanic eruption thousands of years ago, possibly the largest volcanic eruption ever. It is one of the deepest lake in the world, and features an island in the middle called Samosir.

Old Motorcycles with sidecars serves as public transportation in Pematang Siantar. These are mostly old British motor-cycles; BSAs, AJS', Nortons from '49 to '53, kept alive by sheer local ingenuity.

Colorful boats connects Parapat, on the lake's shore with Samosir island.





The grand **Maimoon Palace** in Medan, is the palace of the former Sultanate of Deli, ruler of the area until early 20th century. Designed by an Italian and built in 1888, it features a mix of Oriental, Middle Eastern and Western architectural style

The bustling city of **Medan** is the capital of North Sumatera, and the third largest city in Indonesia, after Jakarta and Surabaya.

Medan is a multi-cultural city, inhabited by the indigenous North Sumatran Batak people as well as Javanese, Chinese, Minang, Indian, and other ethnic groups, creating an unique culture. Each ethnics contributes to thousands of tasty, mouth-watering dishes that can be found in every corner of the city.

The "**Al Mashun**" **Grand Mosque**, located not far from the palace, was built by the Sultan of Deli in 1906.



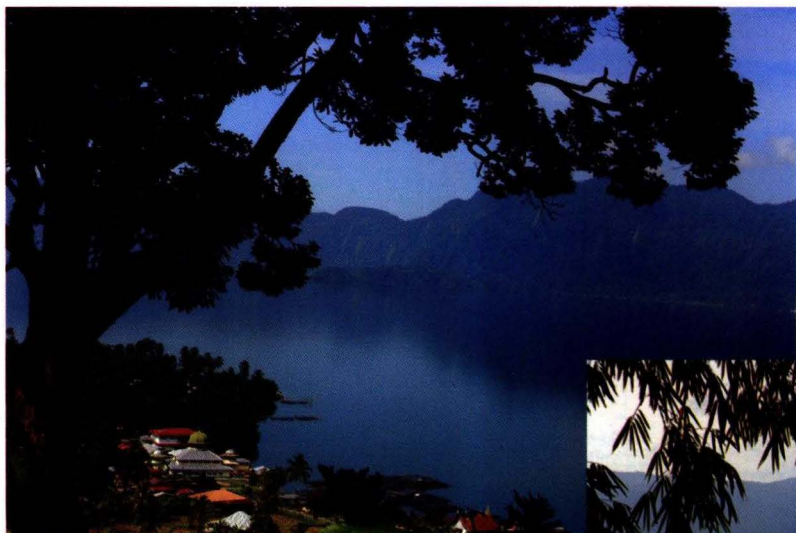

▲ This scenic, winding road is called Kelok 44, literally "44 turns".

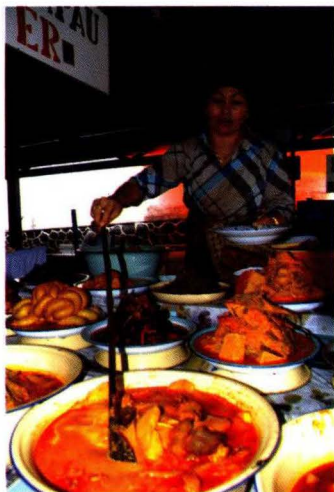
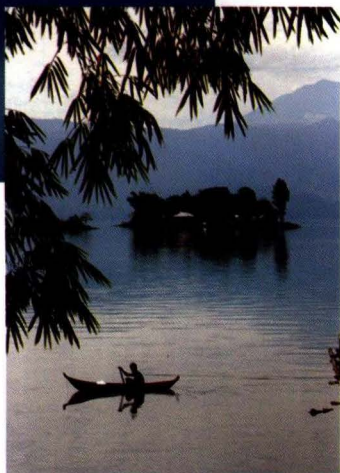

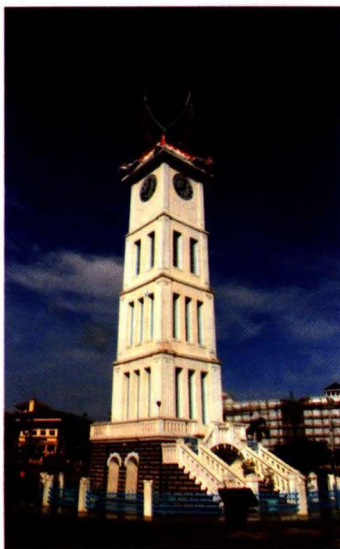


Lake Maninjau is a scenic lake not far from the highland city of Bukittinggi.

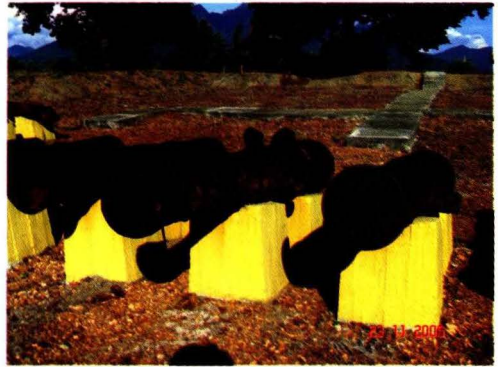


Jam Gadang or literally “the big clock” in Bukittinggi was the gift from the Queen of the Netherlands, and was built in 1926.



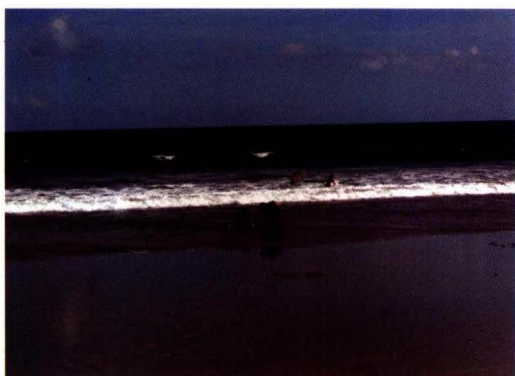

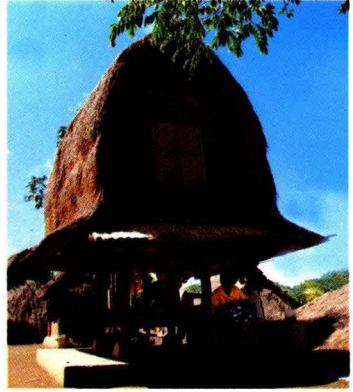


▼ **Ulundanu temple at Bedugul** is located on Lake Beratan, some 1400m above the sea, surrounded by lush rain forest.





Lombok's beaches are every bit as good as Bali's, as both islands are in similar geographic area.



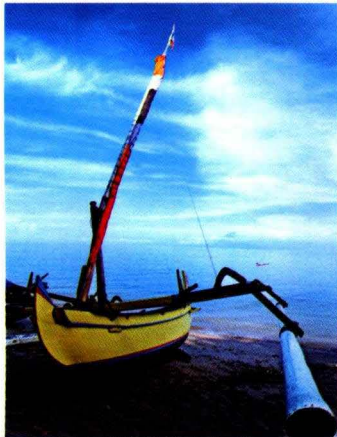
The **Sasak** people is the native inhabitants of Lombok. That is an example of their traditional house.

Lombok is an island directly east of Bali, and features similarly stunning landscape and pristine beaches, but in a more natural, less developed, less 'touristy' settings.

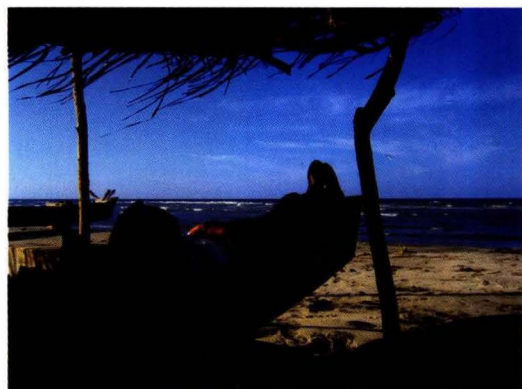
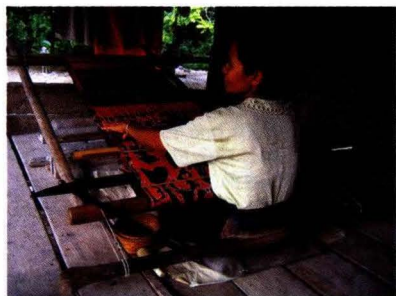

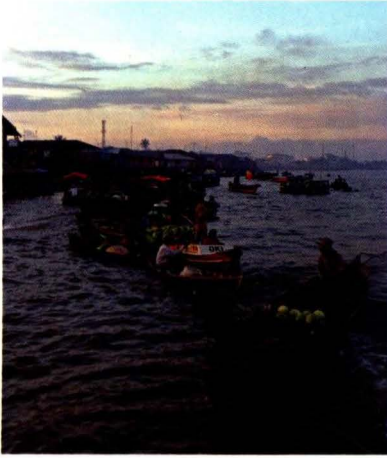
Sumba island is an island in the Eastern Indonesian province of Nusa Tenggara Timur.

North of Sumba island lies Komodo island, the only place in the world where the giant Komodo dragon lives.



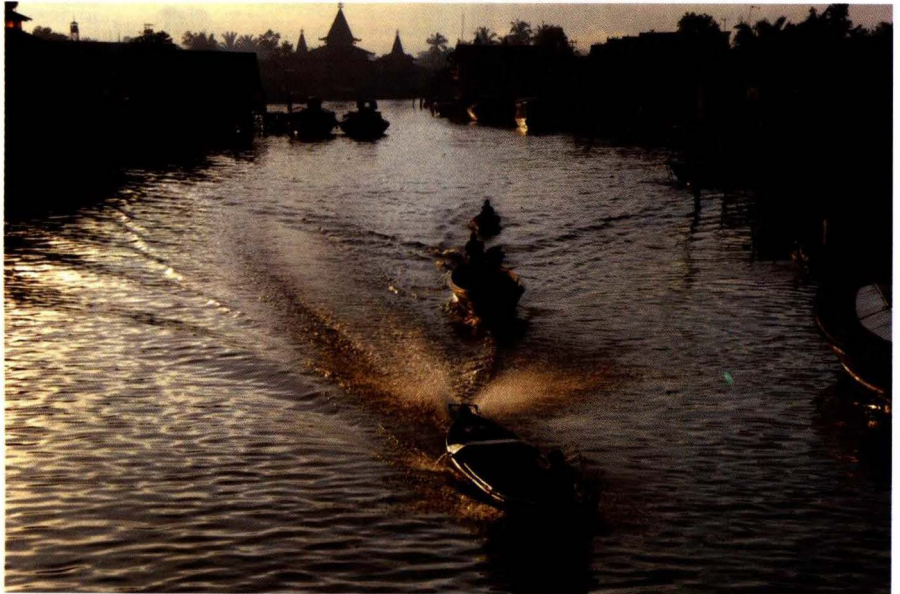
Gorgeous beaches is a feature common to many Indonesian islands, and Sumba's pristine natural beaches are still untouched by the tourism trade.

Banjarmasin the capital of South Kalimantan is a city defined by the large Barito river.

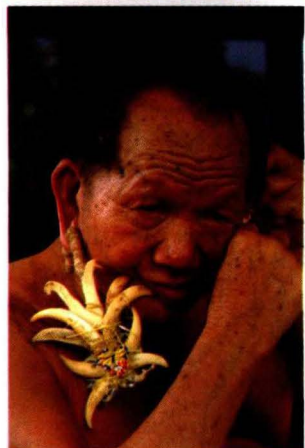
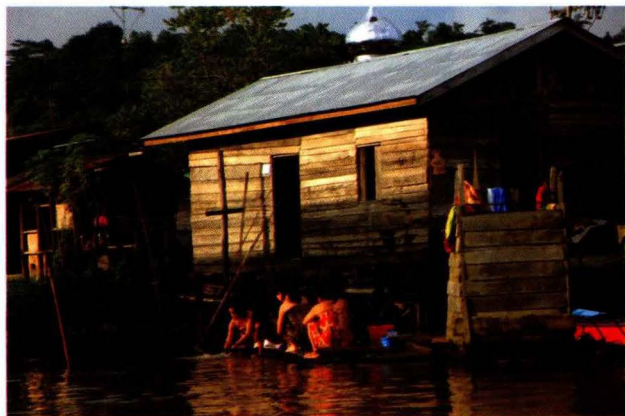

The Dayak people's ceremonial outfit is colorful and heavily accessorized.

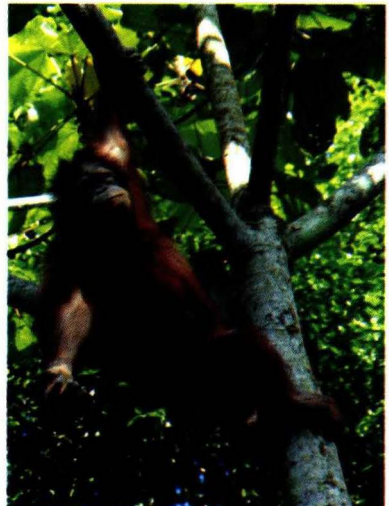


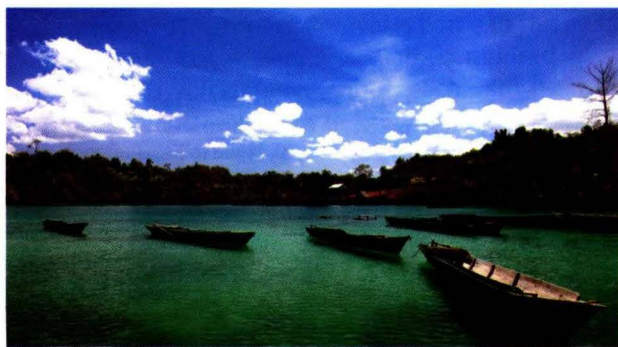

The Tana Toraja (Toraja land) in South Sulawesi has distinct and unique culture, deeply rooted in ancient traditions and beliefs. .

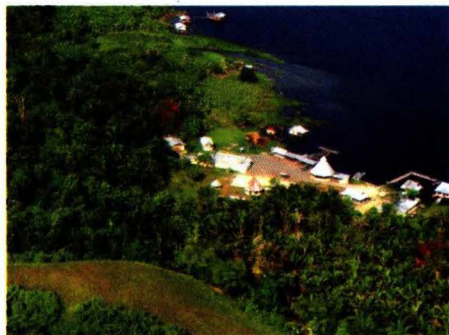
